Parental knowledge - together we are strong

Being a parent or guardian means dealing with a lot of challenges. One of them is supporting children during their education. The project "parental knowledge – together we are strong" aims to assist parents and guardians with children aged from 5 to 11 who wish to promote their children's education. The focus lies on the development of educational opportunities and the creation of a space for exchange between parents and guardians.

- "Parents' guides": So called "parents' guides" (mothers, fathers or guardians) are trained to accompany fellow parents, broadening and deepening their knowledge in the field of education while organizing so called "education parties" ("Bildungspartys"). The parents' guides are remunerated for each education party they organize.
- Education parties: During the education parties the parents' guides provide information about educational topics like the Austrian education system, parents' rights, and everyday life with school children. They also offer information about institutions that provide consulting services and financial support. Parents can choose from a prepared set of topics. To create a pleasant atmosphere the education parties take place in familiar environments, for example at home, in different community spaces, outdoors or wherever the parents feel comfortable.
- Lectures: In addition to the education parties we also offer small lectures by specialists to deepen the acquired knowledge.
